Sacrament of Baptism

We look forward to celebrating this first Sacrament for your child with your family. Baptism Prep is held three times per year in our Parish.

Sacraments of Confirmation/First Holy Eucharist

These Sacraments are celebrated together in May or June each year. Registration for the Sacrament Prep for Confirmation/First Holy Eucharist begins in January. This is open to children in Grade 2 and up.

Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist

Holy Mass is celebrated throughout the week and on the weekends. Please check a current bulletin for the schedule.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated 30 minutes before each weekday and weekend Holy Mass.


Sacrament of Marriage
