We are now entering the Second Week of Advent and the theme is **peace**, which we receive through God's infinite, unfathomable love for us. And as we continue on this journey of waiting and expectation for the coming of Christ, I invite you to receive the sacrament of reconciliation before Christmas.

This sacrament is an opportunity for us to feel that unconditional love of God. We all sin. We all move away from God from time to time. But we are blessed to be able to completely heal that relationship. We can go to confession, receive absolution and do penance. We are transformed by this healing sacrament and like all sacraments, we receive God's grace which helps us to be a better version of ourselves going forward.

It is truly fitting to receive this sacrament during Advent, the season of preparation. The most important thing you can do to receive this sacrament is to prepare. Really reflect on what you need to confess. Spend time in prayer asking Jesus to heal you and the Holy Spirit to guide you in making a good confession.

I invite you to take part in this traditional Advent cleansing and healing at our Advent Reconciliation and Adoration evening on Thursday, December 14 from 7-9pm. I have invited a few priests from our deanery to hear confessions. If you can't be there at 7pm, that's ok. Please join us anytime before 9pm. And if you haven't received this sacrament in a long time, maybe even many years, really pray and discern about receiving this sacrament. My prayer is that everyone experiences the healing and grace that is so generously offered to us.
