Pastor's Corner

As I prepare for Advent, I have been reflecting on the three paths to holiness that we studied in the Bible Study. I really was intrigued by Bishop Barron's talks and want to share some thoughts with you.

The first path is Finding the Center. God is our center. In all we do we have to have God as the priority—in our work, our prayer life, our family life, our entertainment. Everything is centered on God.

The second path is You Are A Sinner. We are all broken. We all sin. And recognizing that we are sinners, asking for forgiveness, doing penance, and trying to not repeat our sin is a huge part of growing in our relationship with Jesus. Join us for our Advent Reconciliation and Adoration evening on Thursday, December 14 at 7pm. We have a few priests from our deanery who will be here to hear confessions.

The third path is Your Life Is Not About You. This particularly gave me lots to reflect on. We are often really wrapped up in ourselves—our celebrations, our troubles, our sadness, our joy. And we need to remember that true joy, the joy that comes from Jesus, comes from us serving our Church, our families, and all people in our lives.

As you begin your Advent journey, I encourage you to spend some time in prayer, reflecting on these three paths. God bless,

1st Sunday of Advent: 1st Reading: Is 63:16b-17, 19b, 64:2-7

Paul reminds us that God will be with us to the end of the age, and by him, we are called to fellowship with his son, Jesus Christ. Advent is that time of preparation, of repentance, of transforming our bodies, minds, and souls to prepare for the welcoming of Christ into the world at Christmas. This is the last week of the 2023 Archbishop's Appeal. We have journeyed and heard the stories of the many areas the Archbishop's Appeal contributes to, and we ask for your generosity. Henri Nouwen, the great spiritual master, has these words for all of us to consider: "Fund-raising is precisely the opposite of begging. We are inviting you to invest yourself through the resources that God has given you—your energy, your prayers, and your money—in this work to which God has called us.' water, which yield their fruit in its season, and their leaves do not wither.' (Ps 1:3)"
