- ☪ Do I make regular contributions to help in the upkeep and operations of my Parish Home? Is my Financial Giving generous? When was the last time I increased my contribution?
- ☪ Will this ministry be a good fit with any other vocational calling God has given me? If I am a parent or spouse, for example, will I be able to remain responsible to those callings?
- ☪ How much time in my schedule can I realistically dedicate to serving Christ?
