

SACRAMENTS OF CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY EUCAHRIST

"And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. This promise is for you, for your children, and for all who are far away. It is for everyone the Lord our God calls to himself."

(Acts 2:39)

The sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Eucharist are celebrated together in the Archdiocese of Regina for all children in Grade 2 or older. The preparation for these sacraments will take place in the Church, in the school and in the child's home. Registration forms have been sent out through the Catholic schools and they are also available at the entrances of the Church, at the Parish Office and on our website (stjohnthebaptistestevan.com).

On Wednesday, January 31, there will be a Parents' Meeting at 6:30pm. And Wednesday, February 7 at 6:30pm we will be hosting another Parents' Meeting. You must attend one of these Parent Meetings. The children do not attend these meetings, it is only for the parents. Both meetings will be held in the Parish Hall. This meeting will give you an outline of the sacrament preparation.

If your child is older than Grade 2 and has not received the sacrament of Baptism, and you would like them to receive the sacraments of Confirmation or First Holy Eucharist, please contact Connie at the Parish Office to discuss a plan.

The Santo Niño de Cebú: is a Roman Catholic title of child Jesus Christ is popularly considered the official patron of Cebu, associated with a religious vested statue of the infant Child Jesus venerated by many Filipino Catholics believing it to be miraculous. It is the oldest religious christian image in the Philippines, that was originally given in 1521 as a baptismal gift by Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan to native Cebu chieftain.

He introduced Christianity to natives and presented the image of the Santo Niño (Holy Child Jesus) as a baptismal gift to Hara Amihan, a wife of Cebu's Rajah Humabon who was later named Queen Juana as a symbol of their new alliance.

The Santo Niño image has many replicas, a various copied version from the original old one from Cebu which kept and encased within bulletproof glass in a chapel at the Basílica Menor del Santo Niño.

The Holy Child's feast is liturgically celebrated every third Sunday of January, during which devotees carry a portable Santo Niño image onto the street fiesta dancing celebrations.

Nowadays. this Image normally seen in many Filipino homes and business establishments, public transport, and even some offices making it as one of the beloved & recognizable cultural icons in the Philippines, found in both religious and secular areas.

You are invited to celebrate Santo Niño de Cebú with us on Saturday, January 20 with a blessing at the 5pm Holy Mass followed by a social in the Parish Hall.
